Moot court is a simulated court experience where law students argue hypothetical cases. It helps students develop their advocacy skills, legal research abilities, and understanding of courtroom procedures.

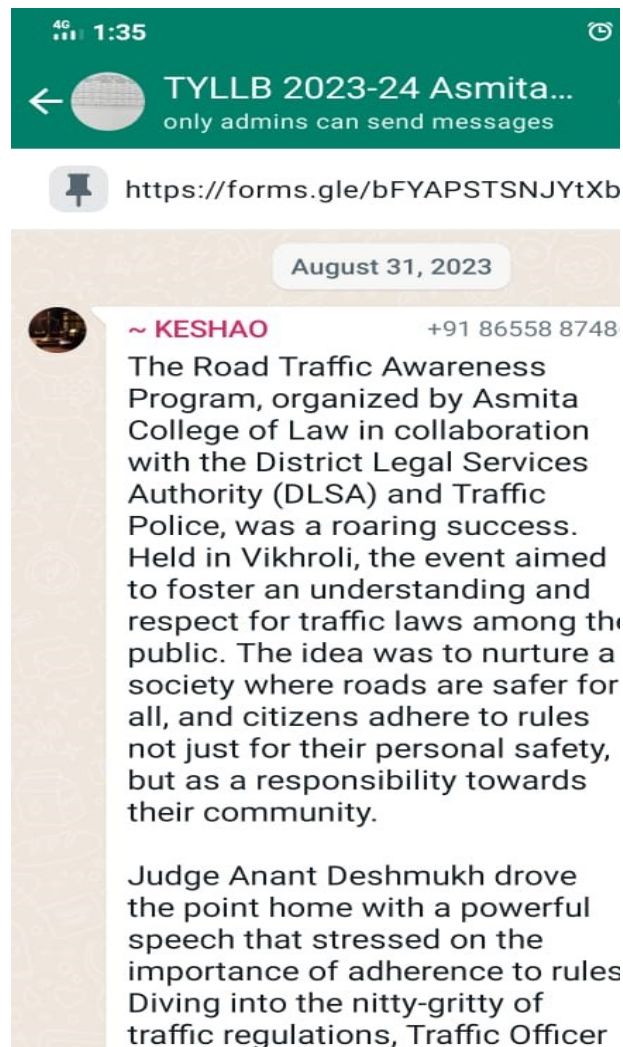
