SYLLABUS

1. INTRODUCTION TO CORPORATE LAW:

A summary of the core ideas, theories, and concepts in corporate law, including the rules that apply to businesses and the people who own them.

2. COMPANY LAW:

It is the study of the legal issues involved in creating, structuring, and administering corporations. It covers the corporate personality, different sorts of businesses, the incorporation procedure, bylaws, and corporate governance.

3. CORPORATE GOVERNANCE:

It studies the systems, procedures, and controls that guarantee efficient management and oversight of organizations. This covers executive salary, shareholder rights, the board of directors' duties, and the boardroom dynamics, among other things.

4. MERGERS & ACQUISITION:

Analysis of the legal and regulatory elements of business transactions, such as mergers, acquisitions, joint ventures, and divestitures, is called "mergers and acquisitions."
